Overview :

This three-day, instructor-led course provides delegates with the knowledge and new skills needed to implement and manage a Microsoft Windows Server™ 2003 networked environment.

Target Audience :

This course is intended for systems engineers with experience planning, implementing, and supporting a Microsoft Windows NT® 4.0-based network. The course specifically targets delegates who have practical, hands-on experience using Windows NT 4.0 and who need to quickly learn how to apply those skills in a Windows Server 2003 environment.

At the end of the course, delegates will be able to:

- Explain the features of the Windows Server 2003 family.
- Implement a Domain Name System (DNS) server.
- Manage and monitor Domain Name System.
- Install the Windows Server 2003 Active Directory® directory service.
- Create and manage Active Directory objects. Implement Group Policy to centrally manage a Windows Server 2003 family network
- Configure and manage a user environment by using Group Policy.
- Configure and support network access.
- Secure network traffic and data files.
- Use advanced boot options, the Recovery Console, and the Backup utility.
- Restore data by using the Backup utility in Windows Server 2003. Plan and implement secure Routing and Remote Access.
